

SPECIAL MAGISTRATE – CITY OF STARKE

THE CITY OF STARKE IN BRADFORD COUNTY, FLORIDA, IS ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS FOR THE POSITION OF SPECIAL MAGISTRATE. The primary duties of the Special Magistrate are as follows:

- Work with City Zoning and Code Enforcement staff to hear and adjudicate Code Enforcement matters
- To impose administrative fines and other non-criminal penalties as appropriate
- To work with attorneys, public/private agency representatives and others who are active participants in the Code Enforcement/Zoning proceedings referenced above

All work will be performed in the City of Starke and for the City of Starke.

TO BE ELIGIBLE AS A SPECIAL MAGISTRATE, AN APPLICANT MUST BE A GRADUATE OF AN ACCREDITED LAW SCHOOL, A MEMBER IN GOOD STANDING WITH THE FLORIDA BAR WITH AT LEAST 5 YEARS OF RESPONSIBLE EXPERIENCE IN THE PRACTICE OF LAW. ***RESTRICTIONS ON CONTINUED PRACTICE OF LAW: APPLICANTS SHOULD ACCESS/READ APPROPRIATE FLORIDA SUPREME COURT JUDICIAL ETHICS ADVISORY COMMITTEE OPINIONS AND ANY OTHER APPLICABLE LAW OR CODE OF ETHICS.
