Mayor Nugent called the workshop to order regarding the progress of the BCR issues. Present were Commissioner Tommy Chastain, Commissioner Carolyn B. Spooner, Commissioner Wilbur Waters, Commissioner Travis Woods, City Clerk Ricky Thompson, City Manager Tom Ernharth, Kyle Jerrels, and Attorney Sikes.

Mayor Nugent turned the workshop over to Mr. Ernharth.

Mr. Ernharth explained the reason for the workshop is to discuss the operation of the BioChem system by BCR. With the current status of the BCR system the City agreed to have BCR come and operate the system for eight batches.

Mr. Jerrels reported after BCR ran the batches they found the following issues with programming and equipment.

Attorney Sikes added he along with Mr. Ernharth and Mr. Jerrels will compose a letter to BCR asking them to come before the Commission to discuss the issues; a so called mini trial to address the issues and a resolution.

If they decline to appear that might be the time for the City to cut its losses and pursue legal action for breach of contract.

Mayor Nugent asked if any additional information needed to be brought in front of the workshop; hearing none he closed the workshop.
